

Youth Worker (2 Positions) – Canada Summer Jobs

Position Overview

We are hiring **two (2) Youth Workers** through the **Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ)** program. These positions are designed to provide meaningful work experience while supporting the delivery of programs and services for children and youth in a safe, inclusive, and community-based environment.

Eligibility Requirements (CSJ)

Applicants must:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of employment
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person with refugee protection status
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada

Key Responsibilities

Program Support & Delivery

- Assist in planning, organizing, and delivering youth programs and activities
- Support summer camps, group programs, and community events
- Prepare materials, set up program spaces, and assist with clean-up
- Assist in organizing youth and young adult engagement activities (e.g., discussion groups, community gatherings)

Youth Engagement

- Build positive and respectful relationships with children, youth and young adults
- Encourage participation in group activities, recreational programs, and community initiatives
- Help create a welcoming and inclusive environment for participants

Leadership & Teamwork

- Assist in leading small group activities, games, and discussions
- Work collaboratively with staff and volunteers
- Demonstrate responsibility, initiative, and a positive attitude

Administrative Support

- Assist with registration, attendance tracking, and basic program records
- Support communication with participants and families under staff supervision
- Assist with outreach and promotional materials (e.g., posters, announcements, social media)

Health & Safety

- Follow all organizational policies and procedures related to health and safety

- Assist in supervising participants during activities
- Report any concerns to supervisors in a timely manner

Qualifications

- Post-secondary student (preferred)
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work effectively in a team environment
- Experience working with children or youth is an asset
- Mandarin language skills are an asset
